JSA BOARD MEETING MINUTES March 14, 2015

Called to order 9:38 AM in conference room 224 at city hall.

Minutes of February 7, 2015 meeting – approved/no changes.

Agenda changes (Subjects 8, 9 & 10 below, added)

Old Business

- 1. JSA Building room rental report Bob
 - Month-to-month rental agreement signed with Coppa owner; \$100/month, favorable indemnity/liability terms included; verbal agreement that only owner & manager have access;
 - Area cleaned up, old wire latch replaced with new lock & auto-shut off on furnace repaired & furnace in good condition
- 2. Dimond Park Storage Shed Update Bob
 - MOU with Parks & Rec signed to allow JSA to have shed at DP; location yet to be determined, possibly next to TMHS shed near right field line of DP4;
 ACTION ITEM: Bob to discuss & work out location with Colby;

New Business

- 1. Online Registration Update Bob
 - Early glitches with first 3 team signup attempts, fixed & now running smoothly; to date, 5 teams fully registered;
 - **ACTION ITEM:** Bob to have login option appear on JSA home page;
 - Per an inquiry, system won't let 2 players share same email address;
 - ACTION ITEM: Bob (already planning) to give fully registered teams first dibs on practice time/field via call from Bob
- 2. **March 18 Registration** Assignments 6:15 River Bend Library
 - Kyle, Pete, Dave, Jane and Brodie (late) will be there
 - Bob will have forms showing online team/player registrations/payments
- 3. **Classification meeting April 4** at ISA Bldg
- 4. Season Scheduling

- Bob concerned that online system unlikely to be able to handle all scheduling & that Mark Kappler's services will still be needed; Mark is willing to help
- DP 4 not available til June

5. Team Practice Adjustments

- Bob requested Board consideration of scheduling/paying for 1 team practice instead of 2, for a \$1000 savings
- Brodie noted lower division teams need more practice, but understood reason; noted that practice turnout is better for some teams more than others & that weather often a factor; reduction to 1 JSA-sponsored practice, wouldn't prevent teams from organizing practices;
- BOARD ACTION: MOTION to reduce current 2 pre-season practices per team to 1 pre-season practice per team

MOTION PASSES

ACTION ITEM: Bob to schedule practices a week later, post pdf of JSA practice schedule & check with P & R about online availability of complete field schedule so teams can organize practices

6. Sandy Beach Update

- Fields have been dragged, look good & will be used in scheduling
- Sleep loss concern for Bob if they're a no-go
- 7. P & R Request to place 1 (not 2) pitcher's mound/plates(s) on field
 - P & R putting new plates/mounds on fields—would like JSA concurrence
 - Safety issues with 2 plates discussed
 - ACTON ITEM: Bob to convey consensus that 1 plate is fine & request that it be sited per ASA distance requirement, with chalk line drawn 5' behind plate

8. Commitment Line Rule

- Dave asks that earlier discussion be revisited & rule amended to be clear that once a player crosses line, if he/she 're-crosses' line, it's an out; Brodie agreed rule was open to interpretation & source of argument w/ certain inclined team manager/players
- Discussion whether rule needed amending; Bob read rule aloud
- BOARD ACTION: MOTION to amend Commitment Line Rule by adding:
 When a runner crosses the commitment line going to home plate, once
 the player crosses the line, he or she can not change direction and re cross the line back towards 3rd base, except as allowed by an exception
 noted in the rule, ie, to tag up on a caught fly ball.
 MOTION PASSES unanimously

9. One Pitch Tourney

- Bob reports from talking to Bob Sims & Everett, that it is uncertain whether
 JDOA will be doing the One Pitch Tourney; has been May 1 in the past;
- Standard bantering re wood bats & one-pitch pros & cons

- Discussion re JSA stepping in, but Bob & Board consensus that time & immediate online registration, season scheduling & early May tournament workload make it unfeasible;
- 10. Coed Division Classifications/Crossover Rules
 - Kyle noted that Flying Squirrels' move up to Men's D, will impact 3 Coed E teams, all of which will now have more than 3 upper division men... which could mean (if they have to move from coed E to D) there won't be much of a Div E coed (ie, only McGivney's b/c no Houligans this year)
 - Danielle noted frustration & difficulty w/ recruiting women for Women's C, b/c women often want to play with boyfriends, etc on lower division coed teams
 - Brodie noted de facto impossibility of 5 guys on a Coed G team playing any men's ball, because they could only go *up* to Men's F; he suggested removing the player number restriction & limiting the number of leagues-higher, any player can play (see motion)

BOARD ACTION: MOTION to Amend Coed Classification/Men's & Women's Crossover Rule so that:

Every player on a coed team cannot play for men, 2 leagues higher for women, 3 leagues higher

 Discussion variously about having proposed rule changes go to Rules Committee (Myria, Brodie, Kyle, Katie & Danielle), authority of Board to take action & change rule at current meeting, timeliness of proposed rule change & fairness to members of changing rules after registration is underway and scenarios for classifications if rule is not changed, (ie, creating Men's E division)
