The **Juneau Softball Association** announces the 15th Annual Capital City Coed Tournament. This is a slow-pitch softball tournament from June 7- 9 at Dimond Park.

Format: Round Robin and Double Elimination: Each team is guaranteed 4 games.
There will be an "IF" game. 3 Divisions of Coed Play (If enough entrants)

Awards: 1st place awards in each division. 15 shirts for the championship team, a 10-member All-Tournament Team in each division, and a tournament MVP in each division. MVP awards will be given to one male & one female on the winning team for each game.

Entry Fee: \$300.00

Registrations can be completed online at www.juneausoftball.com or by filling out this form. Roster and payment must be made prior to Classifications.

Schedules: Tournament schedules will be posted and available Tuesday, June 5th. All in-town teams, must be ready to play Friday, June 7th @ 6 pm. **All out of town teams** must be prepared to play by 8pm and may play later games.

Classifications: Saturday, May 25th, 2019 9:30 AM

Each local participant must be a registered coed member of JSA. You will not be allowed to participate in this tournament without a signed player agreement. If you are already a JSA Men's or Women's Division player, you may sign up to play in the tournament as a coed player for \$25, but that does not include play for the rest of the coed season. If you are not a member of JSA, you must do an online waiver or sign a player agreement and pay the \$50 player fee before taking the field. Out of town players must be members of their local association. Only 2 players can be added to a roster after Classifications.

ANNUAL CAPITAL CITY JSA COED TOURNAMENT

OFFICIAL RULES

Teams can add **two** (2) players to their **tournament** roster **after divisions are determined**, subject to the following conditions:

1. If local, the pickup player must be a JSA member in the coed division. (Men/Women players must have paid a \$25 player fee with a signed agreement in the coed division).
2. Men's and Women's division players **added after tournament divisions** are determined are subject to the JSA coed division classification crossover rules
3. Coed players, **added after divisions are determined**, may not be from a higher JSA coed division than the team's assigned division in the tournament, i.e., a coed tournament Division F team may not pick up a coed Division D or E player.
4. No additional players will be allowed after the start of your first game.
5. Players can only be on the roster of one team playing in the tournament. Regular season roster will be considered de-facto roster for tournament, unless JSA is notified otherwise.

Teams may be a combination of local or out of town teams and will be classified accordingly.

The tournament committee or their appointees make final decisions regarding the eligibility of any player or team to participate in this tournament. The tournament committee or their appointees will handle protests on the spot.

Home Run Limit: Two over-the-fence home runs are allowed per game. PROGRESSIVE THEREAFTER: once both teams have hit two home runs, no team shall be more than one home run ahead of the other team. Home runs over the limit will be declared dead ball outs. No ejection for home runs over the limit.

USA Softball rules as modified by JSA will apply. (See the JSA Softball Handbook): Flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct will result in a player or manager being disqualified from further participation in the tournament. Ejection from a game (except for illegal substitution) carries a minimum 1-game suspension. Ejection from season play carries over into tournament play and vice-versa. See JSA coed lineup rules in handbook.

Game time is play time. NO GRACE PERIOD. You must have 8 players on the field to begin a game (4 men/4 women or 3 men/ 5 women), and finish the game with no less than 8 players. In the event of a compression out, the JSA rule is used. (1 compression out at the dropped player's first appearance in the lineup, no further compression out assessed.) Teams falling below the minimum 8 players will be assessed a forfeit. Any team forfeiting two games will be dropped from the tournament.

TIME LIMITS: Round Robin = 65 minutes. Double elimination = 70 minutes. No time limit for Championship Game(s).

Pitch count is (1-1, + extra strike on a 3rd strike foul ball) when the batter comes to the plate will be in effect for the entire tournament.

15-run rule in effect after 5 innings (4 ½ if home team is leading.) **10-run Flip-Flop rule will be in effect in the last inning during bracket play only.**

USA Softball tiebreaker is in effect for all games. During the time limit games, tiebreaker will be invoked at the top of the inning following time expiration or the 8th inning, whichever comes first (Top of the 8th for games with no time limit.)

Home team will be determined by the flip of a coin prior to each game, **except Championship Game** where the undefeated team has the choice of Home or Visitor. A flip of the coin will determine Home team or Visitor in the event of an IF game.

No Infield Practice is allowed prior to any game.

Round Robin Standing determined as follows:

- A. Best overall win-loss percentage.
- B. Best head to head versus opponents tied with. (If teams tied did not play each other, then use C).
- C. Highest run differential i.e., overall runs scored less runs allowed in all round robin games.
- D. Flip of a coin.

Lineups are to be to the umpire 10 minutes prior to game time. Include first & last names.
