Marketing/PR: We have a sponsor for Rainball-Latitude 58 will be donating \$2,000. We will have their logo on the shirts and in the pamphlets. Myria was going to talk to Kimbee about maybe sponsoring the Home Run Derby or Fastest Man/Women. Katie is working on the pamphlet now, needing the logos from sponsors. We have \$25/50/100 spots. Clarena will get the logo from Mario by Friday June 22nd and will get out to the marketing committee to approve. Next year we might try to sell shirts or jackets.

Finance: Not met, Jodie out

Hiring: Will need to have Jodi get this to the Job Center to post. No interest yet.

Pioneer Committee: Traci talked to the 3 nominees for awarding this year-John Boucher, Sue McGowen & Garry Lewis. She will talk with CBJ to see if we can get a big plaque to hang on the side of the concessions stand with all the names on it. Will be a big expense up front but will only need to have the names put on each year. She wants to have a suggestion box for members to nominate pioneers, she will have some criteria that you will need to fill in when nominating.

Improvements: Got most of the supplies. Still short some. Myria will reach out to other user groups to see if they will help with the costs.
